In 1974 as a curriculum unit for the Dr. E. Paul Torrance for an English Language Arts in 1976, 8000 schools in 28 states.

The 80's

In 1980, the program had 32 State Directors and an Open Director for teams in areas not served by state programs. The "Open" idea was created.

The 90's

An Academic team Problem Solving competition was added in 1990.

The 2000's

Dr. Torrance addressed the 15th anniversary of Changing Learning at the University of Georgia, in Atlanta, Georgia.

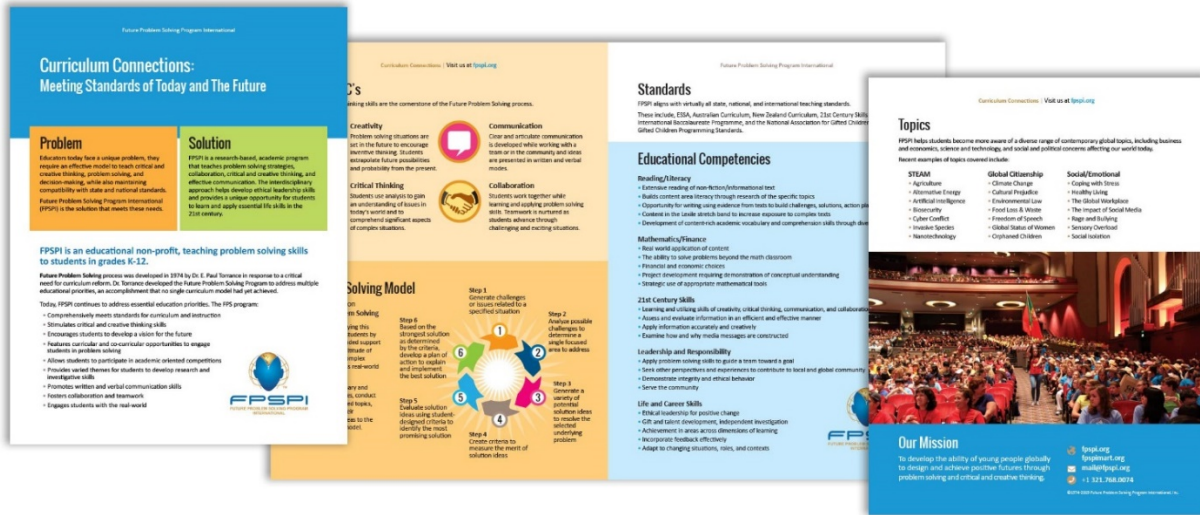
45 YEARS OF FUN FACTS

- In 2019 there were 145 (127 teams, 188 CIPSP individuals, 25 CIPSP teams, 12 CIPSP individuals, 23 Scenario Writing Teams, 34 Scenario Performers, and 179 solvers). 9 Countries were represented.
- Over the last 45 years, the National Book and non-International Conferences (CIPSP) were held at 34 different colleges or universities from the Rockies (CO) to the Eastern Seaboard (VA, CT, RI).
- Since 1974, there have been 74 National Book and 35 International Conferences (CIPSP).
- Eight teachers (directors) have served the program. In 2019, the estimated worldwide FPSP registered participants was 23,905.
